FRIENDS PROJECTS

CRAFT AUCTION

Each year the Friends hold a special Craft Auction to raise money for new books at the library. City Employees, their families and members of the Friends have donated items for the auction. Bidding usually lasts about three weeks. High bids for the previous day will be posted each morning. The Auction usually takes place in mid April.

BOOK SALE

The annual book sale is held in March. Anyone who is a member of the Friends of the Sterling Public Library may attend Patrons Night and have first choice at the books. The money raised from the project helps fund special programs, books and equipment for the library.

Those wishing to donate books to the sale may drop them off at Sterling Public Library.

ADOPT-A-BOOK

This special program allows every member of the community to support the library in an area of interest to them. Books are selected by the participant and may be left in honor of someone special.

MEMORIALS

The Friends of the Library accepts memorial gifts. Donors may specify how each donation is to be used. These gifts can be identified with bookplates or a small plaque. This is a lasting memorial which enhances the gift's value to the community.
