

**CITY OF STERLING  
MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2019**

Nomination Petitions for the City of Sterling Council candidates may be circulated beginning on Tuesday, August 6, 2019. Petitions will be available at the City Clerk's Office, at City Hall, 421 N. 4th Street. The petitions must be returned by 5:00 p.m. August 26, 2019.

For Mayor, the petition needs a minimum of 25 signatures from registered electors residing within the City. For all candidates running for Ward Councilmember positions, 25 signatures are required from registered electors residing in the candidate's ward. No registered elector shall sign more than one nomination petition for each separate office to be filled.

The 2019 City Council election ballot will list the four council positions open which includes one (1) two-year term for Mayor (from At-Large), and three (3) four-year terms of Councilmember, one from each Ward within the city.

The candidate must:

- 1) Be a citizen of the United States.
- 2) Be 18 years of age or older on the date of election.
- 3) Be a registered elector of the City who has resided in the City for twelve (12) consecutive months and in his or her respective ward for at least 90 days immediately preceding the election.
- 4) Be nominated without regard to political party affiliation by petition on forms supplied by the City Clerk.
- 5) Shall continue to reside within the boundaries of the ward in effect at the time of their election throughout the term of office.
